Special Rules

1942 Schwere Panzer Platoon(Heer) - p.27

Escort Tanks

The Tiger Battalions had an escort tank for each Tiger tank to protect them from infantry and anti-tank guns. With their much lighter armour their life expectancy was low.

A 1942 Schwere Panzer Platoon that contains Tiger 1 E tanks does not count Panzer III tanks as Destroyed when determining if it needs to check Platoon Morale.

Reorganisation

The Panzer III was originally issued to the heavy tank units as escorts for the Tiger tanks. Combat proved them rather vulnerable for this role, so many units operated with separate Tiger and Panzer platoons.

Any 1942 Schwere Panzer Platoon may swap all of its Panzer III tanks for all of the Tiger 1 E tanks of another Schwere Panzer Platoon at the start of the game before deployment. The result will be one platoon of Tiger 1 E tanks and one platoon of Panzer III tanks.

Remember to roll for your Tiger Ace Skills before each game.

You may replace up to one Pioneer Rifle/MG team per Pioneer Squad with a Flame-thrower team at the start of the game before deployment.
