Light Panzerspäh Platoons are Reconnaissance Platoons.

Panzerspäh Patrols operate as separate platoons, each with their own command team. Although its patrols operate as separate platoons for all other purposes, Light Panzerspäh, Half-tracked Panzerspäh, or Heavy Panzerspäh platoons deploy at the same time as a single platoon. For example, this means that you treat the entire Panzerspäh Platoon as a single platoon when calculating the number of platoons held in Ambush or Reserve.
