Special Rules

Field Battery, Royal Artillery (1st Army) - p.185

Although a Field Battery, Royal Artillery, Field Battery (SP), Royal Artillery, Royal Horse Artillery Battery, or Medium Battery, Royal Artillery is a single Support choice, each Gun Troop operates as a separate platoon with its own Command team. The Staff team of the HQ Troop must be attached to a Gun Troop from its own battery at the start of the game before deployment (see the British Artillery special rules on page 248 of the rulebook).

Recce Anti-tank Platoon (1st Army) - p.181

British Portee anti-tank guns use the Tip and Run special rule on page 226.

Recce Platoon (1st Army) - p.179

LRC and Carrier Patrols are Reconnaissance Platoons.

Recce Squadron HQ (1st Army) - p.179

The Company HQ of a Reconnaissance Squadron is a Reconnaissance Platoon.

The LRC Patrol and Carrier Patrols operate as separate platoons, each with their own Command team. Although its sections count as separate platoons for all other purposes, a Recce platoon deploys all at the same time as a single platoon. Treat the entire Recce Platoon as a single platoon when calculating the number of platoons held in Ambush or Reserve.
