

Roundstone Clan Background

Sambari Tribe

The tribe holds the land of Saravan's Hills, the Sambari Pass, part of the Tantrell Hills the village of Caroman and Roundstone Fort. Nearby is Fort Enstala – a new fortress town of the Lunar created Enstalos Tribe. Across the pass in Chormsland is the Locaem Tribe with the Balmyr to the south. The Enstalos are to the south-east and Kheldon to the north-east. Currently the tribe has about 7200 members over 5. It is divided into 7 clans with members over 5 as follows. The clans are:

Roundstone: 800
Fire Bull: 500
Caroman: 1200
Heranil: 1000
Thorn Tree: 900
Copper Hill: 1100
Long Runner: 900
Lader: 800

Brief details of the clans are:

Clan	Chief	Details
Fire Bull	Leikan the Ploughman	The Fire Bull clan is traditionally aggressive and anti-Lunar. Their land was devastated in the Firebull Rebellion and their fyrd and weaponthanes killed at the Battle of Gold Hill. The chief who led them in the rebellion was killed. They have lost several steads to the Enstalos and the sad remnants of the clan may well be added to the Enstalos soon.
Caroman	Fantarl Jarstansson	The Caroman Clan controls part of the main road and levies tolls on travellers. They are more involved in trade than other clans and maintain neutrality with the Lunars as far as possible. They stayed out of the Firebull Rebellion.
Heranil	Orgard Swordhand	The Heranil Clan contain many Humakti who serve as mercenaries. They are neutral to the Lunars and stayed out of the rebellion.
Thorn Tree	Illig Black and Blue	The Thorn Tree Clan is traditionally anti-Lunar and joined the Firebull Rebellion. They are known for their skirmishing and hill fighting. They fled early from the battle of Gold Hill avoiding undue casualties but since then Lunar forces have been hunting them in the hills and they have suffered many losses.
Copper Hill	Jistin Copper-Helm	The Copper Hill clan maintains neutrality with the Lunars and avoided the rebellion. They have a copper mine on their land.
Long Runner	Brols Tarosson	The Long Runner clan was originally neutral but joined the rebellion. Their chief and most of their fyrd were destroyed at Gold Hill but some of the weaponthanes escaped. They are now hidden in the hills but the Lunars have been crucifying collaborators to try to draw them out.
Ladar	Jonrik Backstabber	The Ladar clan joined the rebellion reluctantly but were destroyed all the same. Their land is not very good for crops but they herd many sheep. Unfortunately the Lunars have taken most of them.

Some Recent Sambari History

The Sambari tried to remain neutral following the Lunar invasion, keeping to their local traditions but collaborating enough to avoid hostilities. They charge tolls on the road through the Sambari Pass which is a useful source of income and are major slave traders for which they found a good market with the Lunar occupiers.

The Sambari did not support Starbrow's rebellion though some warriors joined the fight against the tribe's wishes. After the rebellion the nearby Kheldon Tribe which had a major part in the rebellion suffered serious reprisals losing their movement powers entirely and being given a Lunar overlord. At this time the Lunars took some clans from the Kheldon and created a new tribe called the Enstalos which now borders the Sambari. At the moment this is quite a small tribe but its numbers are being boosted by settlers from the Empire.

In 1615 Lunar traders arrived at a festival of the traditionalist Firebull Clan. A scuffle began between some young warriors and the Lunars and two traders were killed. Enstalos militia arrived and arrested four of the warriors who were taken to Fort Enstala, tried and crucified for the murder of the Lunar citizens.

The Firebull Clan called a moot and demanded support from the other clans. Thus the Firebull, Roundstone, Long Runner and Thorn Tree went to war with the Enstalos but the other clans refused to support the attack saying that it would lead to war with the Empire. The Samabari army of about 1000 warriors lead by Willandring Thunder-Bull chief of the Fire Bull Clan entered Enstalos lands and burned several steads, defeated some militia and killed some settlers. A force of 1000 soldiers of the Goldedge Foot supported by 500 Enstalos Militia approached from the south and the Sambari fell back into Firebull lands at Gold Hill. There they were joined by the king Torkan White-eye and his weaponthanes. The Lunar forces then united with a relief force of 500 Dogeaters and 500 Arrowstone Cavalry. Polemarch Diotasmus Greatson took command of the Lunar force. The Lunar force moved into Fire Bull lands destroying steads as they went. The rebel army remained on Gold Hill relying on the good defensive terrain to deter a Lunar attack. The Polemarch moved his forces up to the hill and offered battle.

In the battle the Dogeaters advanced up the hill and drove off the Thorn Tree Clan skirmishers who fled the field. The fyrd was then pinned by the Dogeaters whilst the Arrowstones attacked their flanks. The Goldedge Foot then attacked the rebel centre as the Dogeaters moved onto the right flank. Torkan and Willandring died fighting. Many of the rebels were killed or captured during the pursuit. Lunar troops then moved through the lands of the rebellious clans crucifying traitors and ravaging the land.

The tribe chose a new king Roganvarth Loud-Laugh who offered peace to the Lunars. The Enstalos immediately took two of the Firebull's steads and rumour has it that the governor will grant all of their lands to them soon. Confiscations appear likely from the other rebel clans as well.

Tribal Leaders

Orlanth: King Roganvarth Loud-Laugh (b1579). Long-Runner Clan. Initiate of Garzeen Silvertongue. Appointed after the Firebull Rebellion to try to make peace with the Lunars. Considered weak by the rebels and prudent by the other clans. His lack of leadership magic weakens the tribe. He did not fight in the rebellion.

Ernalda: Chief Priestess Elnor Oakleaf (b1581). Wife of Roganvarth. Originally from the Caroman Clan. Initiate of Mahome. Generally thought of as reliable but uninspired. Very supportive of her husband.

Humakt: Tribal Champion Boltar Ironblade (b1587). Heranil Clan. Sword of Humakt. Stayed clear of the rebellion for which some call him a coward (but not often to his face). He has served in mercenary companies in many lands. He is an excellent fighter and a good tactician but is thought to lack much idea of strategy.

Urox: Chaos-Killer Veoslin Watcher (b1570). Ladar Clan. Initiate of Hevduran. There are no Uroxi left in the tribe who aren't in hiding so he is a compromise candidate. He takes a rather theoretical approach to his responsibilities for traditionalists. He was away in Wilmskirk at the time of the rebellion.

Helamakt: Old Gusty Krogar. Roundstone Clan (b 1559). Devotee of Helamakt. The most traditional of council. He is the brother of Thane Unstanus Halfcouncil of the Firivings. He didn't fight in the rebellion because he was suffering from a bout of a recurring illness at the time.

Vinga: Arena Stormcloak (b1591). Thorn Tree Clan. Devotee of Vinga Spearwoman. Her departure before the Battle of Gold Hill has damaged her reputation. She was very keen on the rebellion and seemed very brave when it was going well. She is known to be a good fighter. Some wonder why, considering her prominent role in the early part of the rebellion, why the Lunars haven't arrested her.

Issaries: Speaker and Trader Olav Goldband (b1568). Copper Hill Clan. Initiate of Harst Bronzetongue. A very rich man he spends a lot of time in his house in Wilmskirk where he manages the Copper Hill trading interests. He was not involved in the rebellion and spoke against it at the moot. Rebels consider him to be a traitor and say he secretly worships Etyries.

Lhankhor Mhy: Lawspeaker and Sage Arkekk Forkbeard (b1583). Caroman Clan. Initiate of Lhankhor Knowing. Was not in the rebellion and spoke against it in the moot. Heavily involved in the slave trade with the Lunars. Considered a traitor by the rebels who say he secretly worships Irrippi Ontor.

Chalana Arroy: Healer and Seeker of Peace Chief Priestess Enothea Pale-Eyes (b1581). Copper Hill Clan. Devotee of Pranjala. She spoke against the rebellion at the moot but has retained the respect of most people as her grounds for her position were humanitarian in nature.

Elmal: Hearthguard and Loyal Thane Blinder Bolik (b1579). Heranil Clan. Devotee of Elmal Hearthguard. A dangerous fighter who is more loyal to Boltar than the king. He did not take part in the rebellion.

Asrelia: Elder and Keeper of Wealth Brola Sharpword (b1532). Roundstone Clan. Devotee of Asrelia and Ty Kora Tek. Renowned for her parsimonious ways she is rumoured to control huge wealth by the rebels.

Voria: Child and Bringer of Life Fair Lyzal (b1601). Roganvarth's daughter. Long-Runner Clan. Initiate of Voria. She is loyal to her father.

Eurmial: Trickster and Scapegoat Mad Orfal (b1582). Roganvarth's bonded Eurmial trickster. He is known for bizarre behaviour even for a trickster. He lives in a large barrel in the king's hall and has the magic ability to eat anything. He often devours any unguarded property. Traditionalists doubt that Roganvarth can properly enforce the bond because he is not an Orlanthe.

Roundstone Clan

The clan was once quite big with 1200 people but now has about 900. It is based near Roundstone Fort. The Fort itself lies on top of Hedkoranth Hill. It is held by the tribal king Roganvarth Loud-Laugh and his household and is the location of tribal moots.

The clan joined the Firebull Rebellion and lost 200 of its fyrd including Chief Rurik Ironsword and his weaponthanes at Gold Hill. Lunar troops then crucified many of the remaining rebels and burned many steads. Most of the people fled into the hills to wait for the Lunars to leave whilst most of the surviving rebels fled into exile.

At the end of the year the survivors returned to the steads and began rebuilding. They elected a new chief – Moriv Whitebeard who then asked for peace with the Lunars. Lunar attacks have now ceased but the full question of reparations is still being considered by the governor.

Roundstone Folk Memory

In Asrelia's Age the treasure the ancestors were like was the Rich Swan. In the first ceremony they took part in the Sacrifice Dance. In the Age of Stagnation they helped Umath to defy the Bright Emperor. In the Storm Age the ancestors knew Orlanthe would be great right from the start and joined him immediately. At the wedding of Orlanthe and Ernalda they stood on Orlanthe's side. The clan of the first ancestors was the Urlanthing – the primal Storm People. In the Vingotling Age the clan's ancient enemy was the Praxians. In the God's War the clan's favourite Thunder Brother was Vinga. At the Three Red Peak Battle the clan followed Vikar Orandsson. The subject people the clan sheltered were Buf Gart – the Hungry Women whom the clan enslaved. In the Chaos Age the Broos particularly pursued the clan. To survive the ancestors fled. After the I Fought We Won Battle Heort reorganised the clans. The clan ring was a Storm Ring. In the Silver Age the clan's Unity Allies were the Mostali.

In the Hero Age the clan fought ceaselessly against Lokmayadon no matter how many were killed. When Arkat came the clan raised all its forces to fight against him. In the EWF the clan was hostile to the dragons and fought against them. The lesson the clan learned from the Dragonkill was that it was lucky the clan lived in Heortland at the time. The clan lived in northern Volsaxar and were part of the Volasaxi. When Pharaoh came the clan hated him. They departed right away leaving almost everything behind but got good land in the north. The clan joined the tribe early and gained prestige.

When Sartar came the clan most admired him when he married the Feathered Horse-Spawn Queen and became King of Dragon Pass. When the Red Goddess' missionaries first came to the clan they were killed. After the conquest of Tarsh the clan helped King Tarkolar fight the Lunars and fought honourably but not insanely. After the Lunar victory the clan chose to bide its time until a good opportunity for rebellion came along. When the infighting began amongst the tribes the clan attacked those who had offended them in the past such as the Copper Hill Clan, the Locaem and the Balmyr. In Starbrow's rebellion the clan forbade anyone to fight but some went anyway. The clan generally hate Termertain.

Roundstone Bloodlines

There are 8 bloodlines in the clan. They are shown below with the steads they hold and the approximate number of people over 5 at each plus the number of people in hunting/herding camps and finally in exile. The chief comes from the Ranusi. Rurik Ironsword was of the Firivings:

The Orvalduni – Noble (89), Lade (40), camps (3), exile (3) = 120.

The Firivings – Roundstone Stead (95), Methi Stead (45), Chom Stead (40), camps (5), exile (5) = 190. Thane Unstanus Halfcouncil (b1557)

The Faltikus – Red Horse (70), Jerith Stead (40), camps (10), exile (10) = 130

The Angorovings – Ravine (60), camps (20), exile (5) = 85

The Ranusi – Varntar's Field (75), camps (5), exile (5) = 85

The Engarnusings - Saddle (75), camps (10), exile (5) = 90

The Elnorovings – Reed (75), camps (10), exile (5) = 90

The Brygossi – Stream Stead (60), Eye Stead (35), camps (10), exile (5) = 110

Important Roundstone Clan Members

The Clan is ruled by a Storm Ring. The battering the clan took during the rebellion has left it sadly depleted but a recent moot elected a new ring. The necessity of maintaining the ban on Orlanth in order to avoid further reprisals has resulted in some unusual cults for these leaders as they have been forced to leave their Orlanth subcults. Under the circumstances it seemed wisest not to try to equivocate any further. This has weakened the clan council as the leaders do not have leadership magic.

Orlanth (Chiefton): Moriv Whitebeard (b1551). Initiate of Lhankhor Knowing. Was the clan's Lawthane before the rebellion. From the Ranusi bloodline. He made a sort of peace with the Lunars.

Lhankhor Mhy (Lawthane): Orlev Lawbringer (b1554). Initiate of Lhankor Knowing. From the Ranusi bloodline. Moriv's brother and fellow cultist.

Issaries (Translates the Words of the Gods): Enerin Taxman (b1566). Initiate of Harst Bronzetongue. From the Elnorovings. His main duties are an attempt to raise enough taxes from the clan to satisfy both the king and the Lunars. This has left him with a distracted and worried look. He was originally quite grasping himself but has been making up taxes out of his own wealth.

Hedkoranth (War Leader): Yend Bluesword (b1584). Initiate of Helamakt. From the Brygossi. Yend was the only weaponthane to escape the Battle of Gold Hill. This has left him with a rather difficult reputation as some say he survived by fleeing the quickest. Nevertheless all the surviving clan fyrd either fled the battle or failed to turn up so no one criticises him openly. He has transferred to the Helamakt subcult of Heler.

Esrola (Feeds Clan): Mother Nevana (b1561). Devotee and Chief Priestess of Esra Barley Mother. From the Faltikus. She held this position in the old ring.

Kero Fin (Protects Mothers and Children): Gryffuna Careful (b1552). From the Angorovings. Devotee and Priestess of Votenevra the Earth Healer.

Ernalda (Head of Women): Sora Earthpriestess (b1566). Devotee and Chief Priestess of Roitina. From the Angorovings.

Thunder Brothers and Weaver Women (Outer Ring):

The Orvalduni Thane Yeresti Three-Bull (b1570).

The Firivings Thane Unstanus Halfcouncil (b1557).

The Faltikus Thane Petrad One-eye (b1549).

The Angorovings Thane Dangmet the Bald (b1564).

The Ranusi Thane Fithorf the Generous (b1570).

The Engarnusings Thane Harkolar Hundred-Herd (b1567).

The Elnorovings Thane Longspear Sasar (b1578).

The Brygossi Thane Ingan Oldhelm (b1569).

Leik the Priest (b1554). From the Engarnusings. Chief Priest. Devotee of Helamakt. Pretends to be a Heler worshipper but still officiates at Orlanth ceremonies.

Angtyr Axeman (b1590). From the Brygossi. Initiate of Helamakt. Recently selected. At the time of Gold Hill Angtyr was working as a mercenary in Esrolia. He has returned and is the best fighter the clan has left. He has transferred his cult to Heler to serve the clan.

The Weaponthanes: there are five weaponthanes all newly recruited.

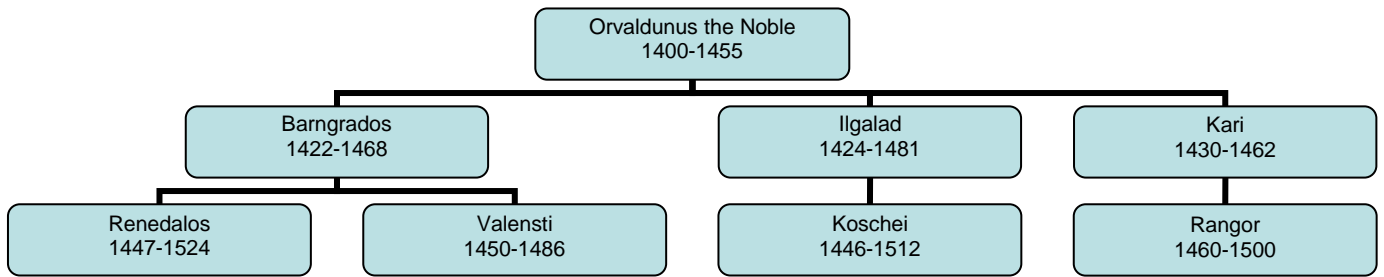

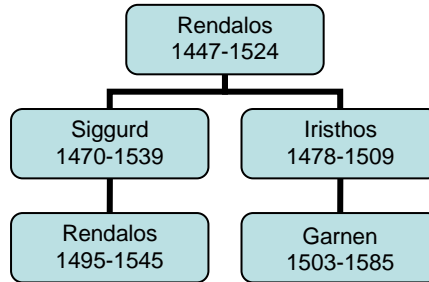
The clan fyrd is weak because of losses at Gold Hill (about 200 in total).

Descent of the Orvalduni Bloodline

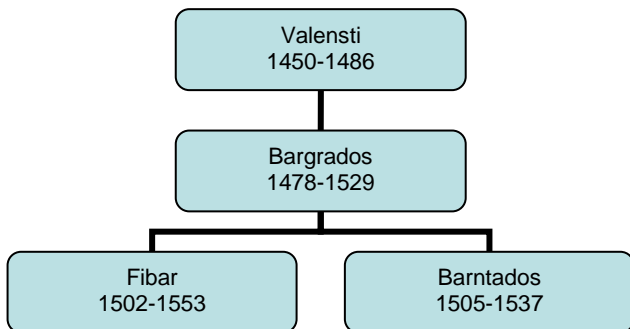
The bloodline was founded in 1420 when Orvaldunus left Roundstone Village in search of new land to farm. The following diagram shows the structure of the bloodline. As inheritance is judged through the male line in the clan only males and living unmarried females are shown in this diagram. Females marry out of the bloodline and come from outside it to marry. Males are only shown if they are either alive today, only died recently or produced male heirs who are alive today. Many other members of the bloodline have no living descendants.



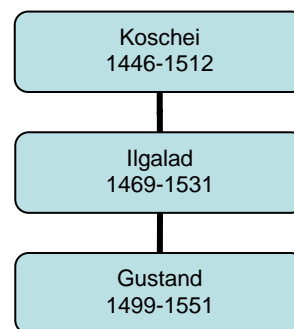
Rendalos Bargradosson's Line:



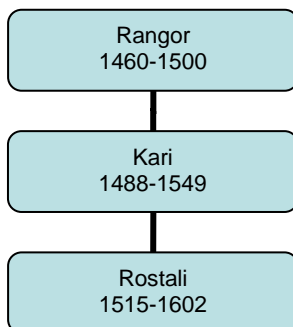
Valensti Barngradosson's Line:



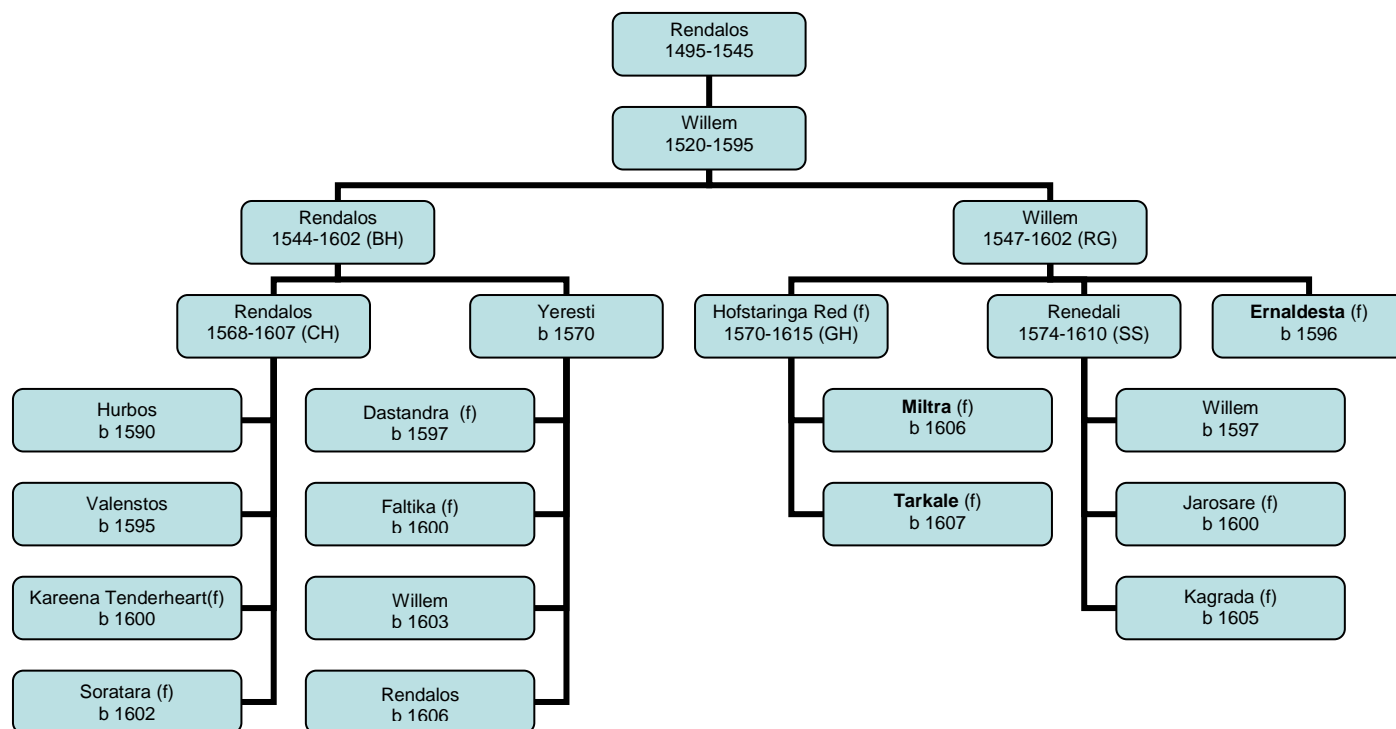
Koschei Ilgaladsson's Line

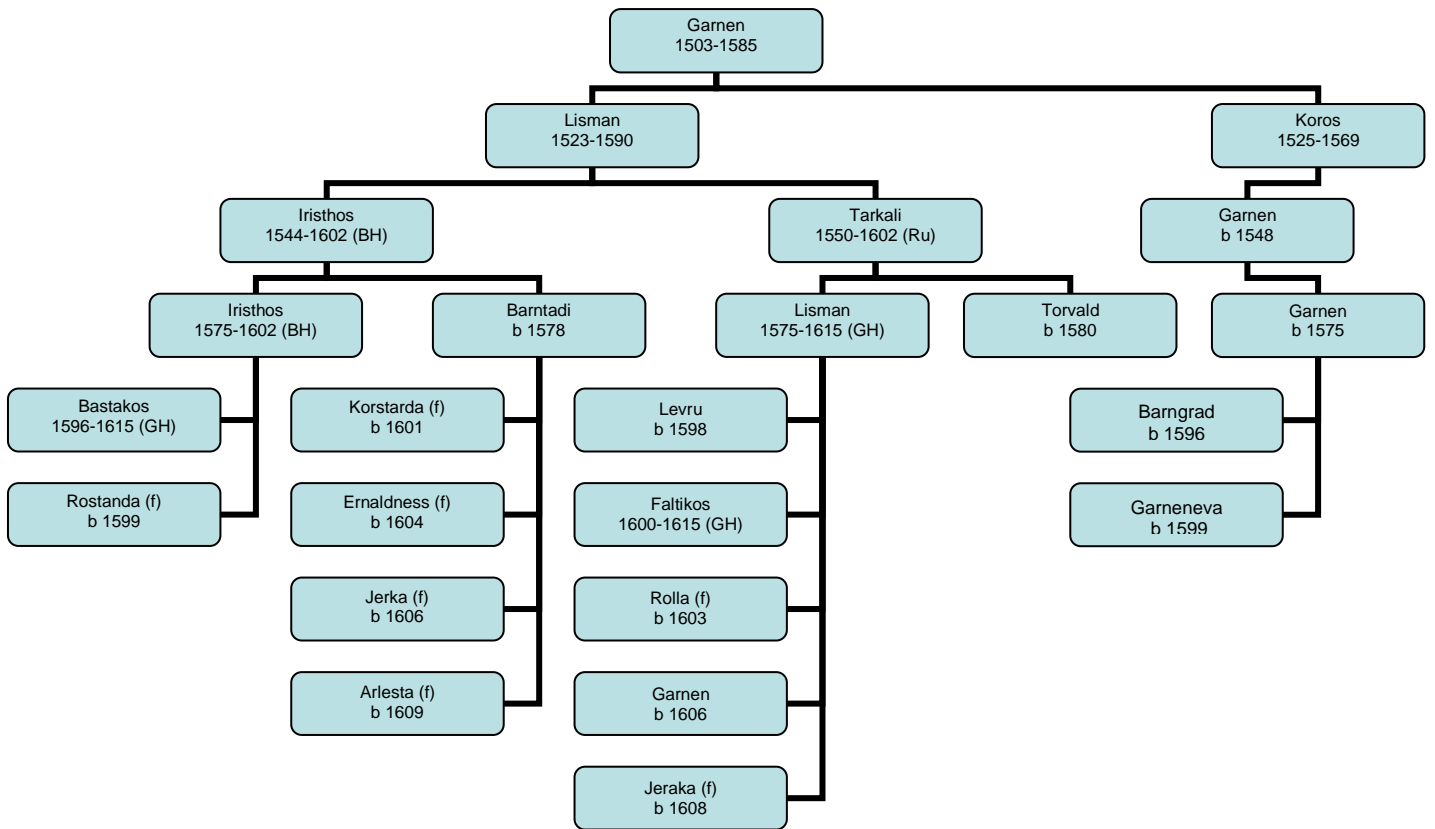

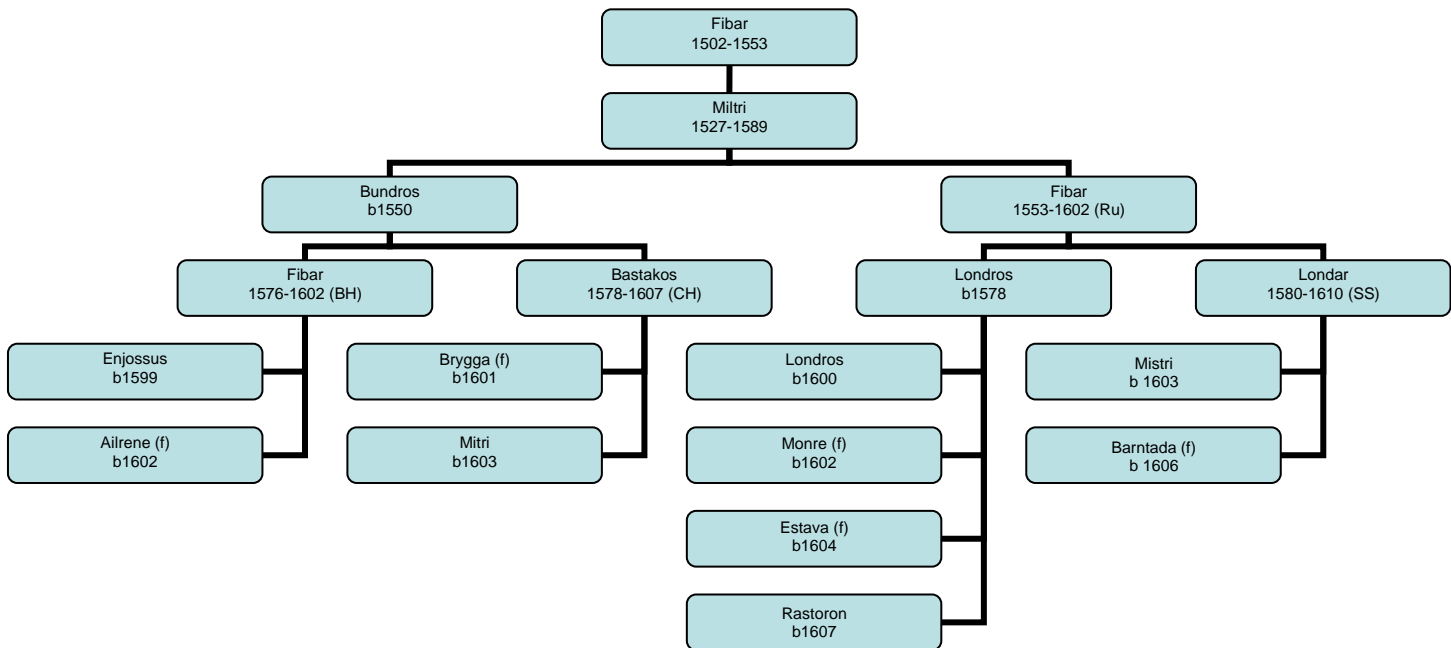

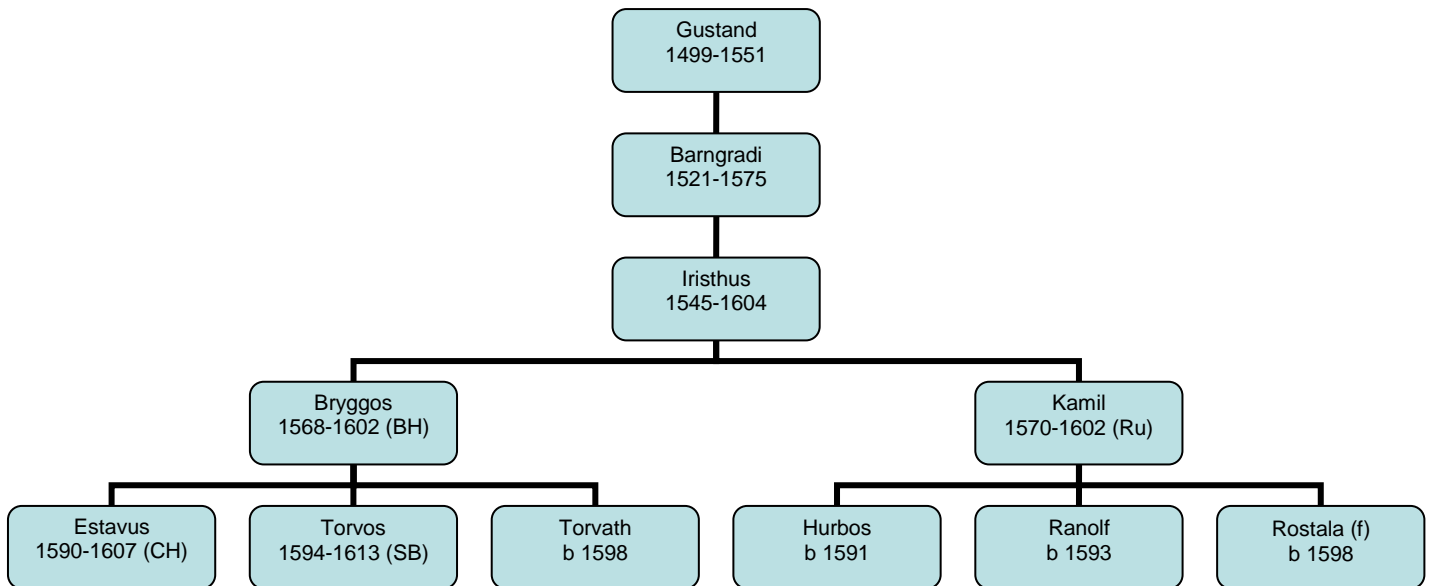

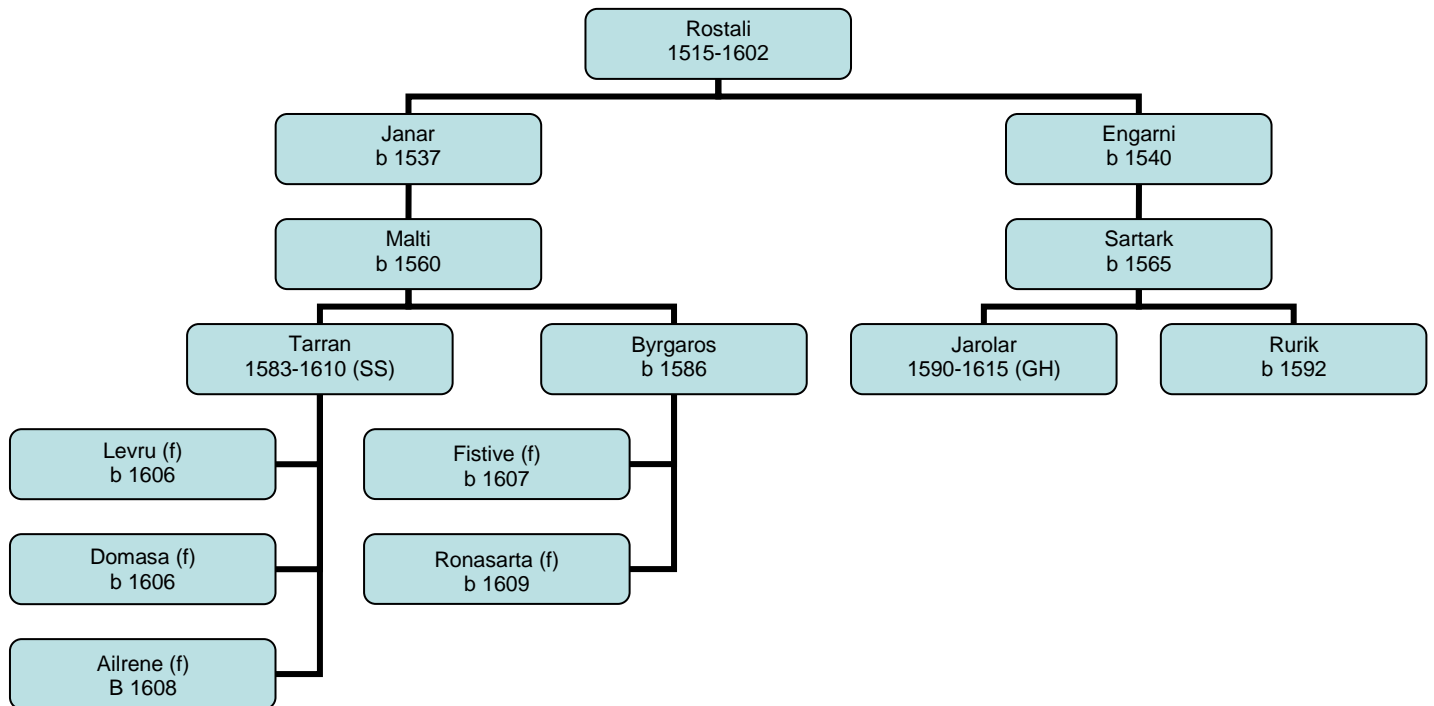

Structure of the Bloodline

This shows the status and age of the bloodline members in 1616. The relationship shown is their most significant relationship to a living person – the one from which they draw their status – and which people will usually refer to first.

Most of the bloodline's men don't worship Orlanth any longer because of fear of the Lunars and also because most of the fighters have been killed. Those who do worship Orlanth pretend not to.

Yeresti has a sword, a mail hauberk and a horse. Lesser Fyrd are armed with clubs, stones and agricultural implements. The bloodline lost 7 members at Gold Hill – fewer than other bloodlines.

Noble Stead

Noble Stead has two longhouses, three smaller houses, one hovel and several outbuildings. It contains the bloodline's shrine. It is surrounded by a small ditch and rampart topped with a palisade. The stead is located where a stream called Neverlass runs down from a group of steep wooded hills to the south called Four Sisters and the Bear. To the east is Four Oak Hill which is sacred to Desemborth and is also topped with an ancient stone burial cairn which is known to be haunted. To the North East is Wild Storm Hill sacred to Great Orlanth. To the North West is Copper Hill where the copper mine is situated. To the south is the Earth Caves – a deep cave system and grotto where ceremonies to Ernalda are held.

Around the stead and along the stream are a number of strips of farmland mostly growing barley. The reasonably flat area on the far side of the stream is used for cattle grazing. Around the houses are gardens growing herbs and a few vegetables. The hills to the south and east are used as the stead's sheep grazing country. Hunting is carried out in the hills to the south-west which are known for wild boar.

The Firivings to the north-east are friendly to the bloodline but they live near to Roundstone Fort where the king has tried to stay out of the Firebull Rebellion. To the north-west the Copper Hill Clan is hostile – whilst not pro-Lunar they are ancient rivals and their trade has suffered as a result of the rebellion. The Thorn Tree Clan to the south is traditionally friendly but the Roundstone Clan felt betrayed by their precipitous flight at Gold Hill.

The most important, and richest, man in the stead is Yeresti Three-Bull who is the thane of the bloodline. Before him the thane was his brother Rendalos Whitehelm, a noted warrior, who died in 1607 at the Battle of Copper Hill. Before that the thane was his father Rendalos Hand-and-a-Half who was eaten by the Bat at Runegate in 1602. Yeresti fought at Gold Hill but managed to escape the rout because he kept his horse handy. Yeresti's wife Rostala Lashtongue and his mother Randana Londrasdotter and the stead's priestesses and his nephew Hurbos Rendalosso is his right hand man.
